<b>Time-tiered general attendances</b>		
<a href="#">44</a>	<p>Level D consultation (≥ 40 mins)</p> <p>Used for taking an extensive patient history; performing a clinical examination; arranging any necessary investigation; implementing a management plan; providing appropriate preventive health care; for one or more health-related issues, with appropriate documentation.</p> <p>After hours: item <a href="#">5060</a>. Telehealth: item <a href="#">91802</a>. Phone: item <a href="#">91910</a>.</p>	\$125.10
<a href="#">123</a>	<p>Level E consultation (≥ 60 mins)</p> <p>For managing care needs of patients with chronic conditions, those in need of advance care planning, palliative care and end-of-life care, and patients needing additional time for proper communications, e.g. patients with dementia, various disabilities, or where an interpreter is required.</p> <p>After hours: item <a href="#">5071</a>.</p>	\$202.65
<b>Comprehensive medical assessments</b> (includes annual aged 75+ and DVA veteran checks)		
<a href="#">701</a>	<p>Brief health assessment (&lt; 30 mins)</p> <p>For simple health assessments including a basic physical examination.</p>	\$69.20
<a href="#">703</a>	<p>Standard health assessment (30-45 mins)</p> <p>For straightforward assessments where the patient does not present with complex health issues but may require more attention than can be provided in a brief assessment.</p>	\$160.85
<a href="#">705</a>	<p>Long health assessment (45-60 mins)</p> <p>For an extensive assessment, where the patient has a range of health issues that require more in-depth consideration, and longer-term strategies for managing the patient's health may be necessary. Might be used to introduce a discussion about advance care planning or palliative care.</p>	\$222.00
<a href="#">707</a>	<p>Prolonged health assessment (&gt; 60 mins)</p> <p>May include an extensive examination of the patient's medical condition, and physical, psychological, and social function. Could be used to introduce a discussion about advance care planning or palliative care.</p>	\$313.60

<a href="#">965</a>	<p>Preparing a GP chronic condition management plan (from 1 July 2025) For working with patients to set goals for treatment/management of their condition(s), establish roles and responsibilities of multidisciplinary team members, and create a structured plan for care. Applies to patients with at least one medical condition that has been (or is likely to be) present for at least six months or is terminal. Telehealth: item <a href="#">92029</a></p>	\$156.55
<a href="#">967</a>	<p>Reviewing a GP chronic condition management plan For discussing and documenting patient progress in relation to their goals and reviewing and updating the plan. Telehealth: item <a href="#">92030</a></p>	\$156.55

<a href="#">735</a>	<p>Case conference (15-20 mins) For organising, coordinating, and participating in, multidisciplinary case conferences for patients in the community, being discharged into the community from hospital, or living in residential aged care facilities.</p>	\$82.50
<a href="#">739</a>	<p>Case conference (20-40 mins) For organising, coordinating, and participating in, multidisciplinary case conferences for patients in the community, being discharged into the community from hospital, or living in residential aged care facilities. Provides an opportunity for holistic informed approach to ongoing care for providers, carers and family.</p>	\$141.05
<b>Medication management reviews</b>		
<a href="#">900</a>	<p>Domiciliary Medication Management Review (DMMR) For community-based patients for whom quality use of medicines may be an issue or patients who are at risk of medication misadventure because of factors such as their co-morbidities, age or social circumstances, the characteristics of their medicines, the complexity of their medication treatment regimen, or a lack of knowledge and skills to use medicines to their best effect.</p>	\$180.65

<a href="#">2700</a>	Preparation of a GP mental health treatment plan (20-40 mins) Applicable to community-based patients with a mental disorder (as per DSM-5-TR criteria) who would benefit from a structured approach to the management of their treatment needs. <a href="#">2701</a>	Preparation of a GP mental health treatment plan (> 40 mins) Telehealth: item <a href="#">92113</a> .	\$123.15
<a href="#">2712</a>	Review of GP mental health treatment plan For assessing and managing the patient's progress once a GP mental health treatment plan has been prepared.
